





## SPECIFICATION OF EPIDIASCOPE No. 25

The Lamp-house is of sheet steel, crystalline enamelled, fitted with helical jacket to take "Beck" Anastigmat lens. The lantern slide lens is our Standard No. 4 series approximately 8-in. focus.

The Object Mirror is silver surfaced and can be adjusted to any position. The Optical Mirror Reflector which is behind the lamp is specially designed for this work, and when correctly adjusted, increases the light considerably on the screen.

When projecting opaque objects, the bottom glass is removed. This allows the article that is being projected to stand on a revolving turntable so that it can be viewed from any angle. This attachment is not fitted in any other make of Epidiascope.

The Lifting Table is raised and lowered by an eccentric spindle at the back of the body, and is fitted with a ratchet, so that the table can be locked in any position and cannot slip down.


A large door is provided at the side and a smaller one at the back of the body, so that the lamp and reflector can be easily fitted or adjusted. The Reflector is mounted in a ball and socket joint ensuring

every adjustment.


The aperture for photographs or books is 6-in. square. There is also an auxiliary mirror fitted inside the body which acts as a cut-off to the lantern slide attachment.

When showing slides, this mirror is lowered. The flap covering the top lens is lowered when not in use. Only one 500 watt lamp is necessary and good results are obtained at a throw of 20-35 feet, with a picture 10 feet square.

When greater illumination is required, the side lamp-house shown here, supplied with the outfit, can be brought into operation by installing another 500 watt lamp, and we strongly recommend the use of the extra lamp, especially where total darkness cannot be obtained.

The Lamp-house is of sheet steel, crystalline enamelled, fitted with helical jacket to take "Beck" Anastigmat lens. The lantern slide lens is our Standard No. 4 series approximately 8-in. focus.

The Object Mirror is silver surfaced and can be adjusted to any position. The Optical Mirror Reflector which is behind the lamp is specially designed for this work, and when correctly adjusted, increases the light considerably on the screen.
